#### **Read Carefully Before Signing**

I choose to voluntarily participate in the Academy Tournament Horse Show, The "Competition". I fully understand that horses can be unpredictable; that being on or around horses involves inherent dangers which can result in serious loss, accident, bodily injury, pain, suffering, or even death. I assume all the risk of harm involved in my participation and I agree to release the Competition from all claims for money damages or otherwise for any harm to me or my horse even if due to the gross negligence of he Competition. I further agree to indemnify the Competition and hold them harmless with respect to claims for harm to me or my horse and for claims made by others for any harm caused by my horse. I understand that no protective equipment can guard against all injures. I have read this entire agreement before signing below and I understand it and further agree to abide by the rules of the Competition.

#### **RULES AND GUIDELINES**

#### **STALLS**

Stalls are limited; first come first serve. Shavings are allowed, however all manure must be removed from the stalls and premises. No manure in the dumpsters! Please help us meet this small request of Alexandria Township so we may continue our use of their facility!

#### NO spectators in the warm up area. Trainers, grooms, and riders only! This will be strictly enforced!

#### **ACADEMY CLASSES**

Academy classes are limited to riders who have never shown in any regular class at any show or Tournament.

Academy riders are not to cross enter into Non-Academy classes at this Tournament.

#### ACADEMY FIRST YEAR / TOURNAMENT RIDER CLASSES

First Year/ Tournament Rider classes are open to riders who have not shown in Academy Classes for over one calendar year or who have only participated at the Tournament Level. Lead-line does not apply.

#### MAIDEN CLASSES

These classes are for riders who have never shown before (excluding in barn fun shows). Lead-line riders who are showing off the lead for the first time are allowed in maiden classes.

#### **ATTIRE**

Neat, clean, casual attire for all classes: Jods, boots, gloves, and polo shirt, sweater or sweatshirt with no logos or writing. No ties, vests, derby's or coats.

#### **HORSES**

All breeds and disciplines are welcome. Hoof blacking and mane braiding are optional. PLEASE BE ADVISED THAT ANY UNRULY HORSE THAT POSES A DANGER TO ITS RIDER OR OTHERS WILL BE EXCUSED FROM THE RING IMMEDIATELY.

#### CHAMPIONSHIP CLASSES

Any rider that was judged in a qualifying class is eligible for their championship class. Championship Classes are to be judged 50% on Equitation and 50% on Showmanship. If Championship includes a Pattern. Judge is required to work a minimum of four riders.

#### **OPEN CLASSES**

Open Classes are for "show riders". On any breed horse and of any discipline.

Academy Riders may not enter Open Classes.

#### **LEVEL 1 SHOWMANSHIP**


Restricted to riders that have special needs and are currently riding in a standard lesson program. A ground person will be allowed in the ring for safety purposes only. Riders in these classes may not cross enter into any other classes at this show.

#### **END OF DAY AWARDS**

#### **OPEN WTC**

- 1. STARTING AT GATE DIVIDE THE STRAIGHTAWAY INTO THIRDS. TROT THE FIRST THIRD ON THE RIGHT DIAGONAL. HALT.
- 2. CANTER THE NEXT THIRD ON THE LEFT LEAD. HALT.
- 3. TROT THE FINAL THIRD ON THE ON THE RIGHT DIAGONAL, HALT.
- 4. REVERSE. TROT A CIRLCE TO YOUR RIGHT AND CONTINUE TROTTING BACK TO THE LINE UP.

#### ACADEMY WT CHAMPIONSHIP AND OPEN WALK AND TROT

- 1. STARTING AT THE GATE END. TROT TO THE CENTER OF THE TURN. SHOWING TWO CHANGES OF DIAGONAL.
- 2. HALT, REVERSE, TROT A CIRLCE.
- 3. CONTINUE TROTTING DOWN RAIL TO THE LINE UP.

#### **ACADEMY/ FIRST YEAR/ TOURNAMENT WTC CHAMPIONSHIP**

- STARTING AT GATE END, TROT TO THE CENTER OF THE TURN SHOWING 2 CHANGES OF DIAGONAL.
- 2. HALT. REVERSE. CANTER A CIRLCE TO YOUR RIGHT. CONTINUE CANTERING TO THE HALF WAY POINT OF RAIL. HALT.
- 3. TROT THE REMAINING RAIL AND BACK TO THE LINE UP.

#### FIRST YEAR/ TOURNAMENT/ MAIDEN WT CHAMPIONSHIP

- STARTING AT GATE END. TROT TO THE END OF THE RAIL SHOWING ONE CHANGE OF DIAGONAL.
- 2. HALT, REVERSE AND TROT BACK TO THE LINE UP.
